The Fish and Wildlife Commission this year voted to increase the sport fishing crab allocation from 33% to 45% of the non-Indian share. The result: expanded crabbing seasons in 2011. The Seattle Boat Show will crank up the heat to educate the sport fishing public—especially the 225,000 who crab in Puget Sound—about knowing the rules BEFORE they go crabbing.
